KS2—Jimmy Humphris for perseverance.

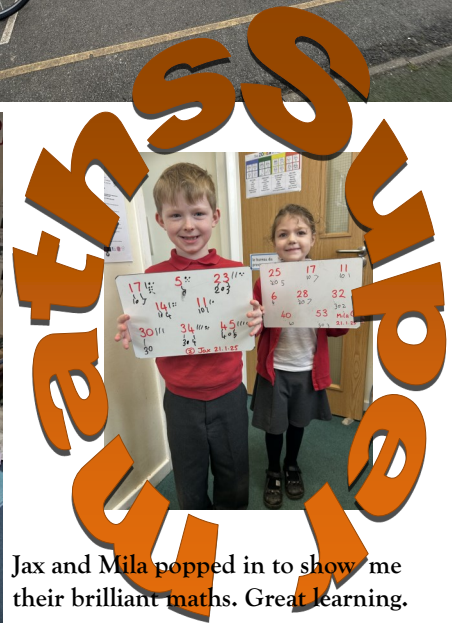
I had a hot chocolate with Josh OH and Thomas yesterday. Next week I will be catching up with Dolcie and Anthony.
