

## **KS2 – 2022/23 Pupils meeting expected standard in reading, writing and maths**

Pupils are meeting the expected standard if they achieve a scaled score of 100 or more in their reading and maths tests, and their teacher assesses them as 'working at the expected standard' or better in writing.

### **Pupils meeting expected standard in reading, writing and maths:**

**National = 59%**

**Offley = 77.3% (Top 83% in country)**

### **Pupils meeting the expected standard in Maths**

**National = 73%**

**Offley = 100%**

### **Pupils meeting the expected standard in Reading**

**National = 73%**

**Offley = 77.3%**

### **Pupils meeting the expected standard in Writing**

**National = 71%**

**Offley = 95.5%**

### **Pupils meeting the expected standard in Grammar, punctuation and Spelling**

**National = 72%**

**Offley = 95.5%**

### **Pupils meeting the expected standard in Science**

**National = 80%**

**Offley = 100%**

### **Average scores**

This score shows how well pupils performed in the key stage 2 tests. The score is an average for pupils in the school. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.

*Average score in reading: 107.32*

*Average scaled score in maths: 107.14*

*Average scaled score in Grammar, punctuation and spelling: 107.32*
